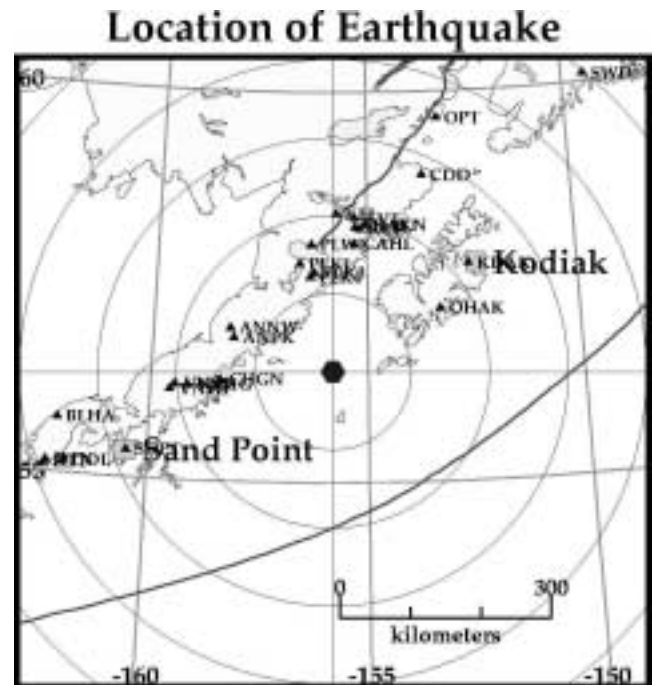
The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a minor earthquake that occurred on Thursday, June 12th at 3:13 PM AKDT in the Alaska Peninsula region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 3.7 and was located at a depth of about 28 miles (44 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. No reports of this event being felt or causing damage have been received at this time.

Distance to nearby locations::

115 km ( 72 miles) WSW of Akhiok  
152 km ( 95 miles) SSW of Karluk  
160 km ( 100 miles) E of Chignik  
165 km ( 103 miles) SE of Pilot Point  
166 km ( 104 miles) E of Chignik Lagoon  
167 km ( 104 miles) SW of Larsen Bay  
176 km ( 110 miles) WSW of Old Harbor  
183 km ( 115 miles) ESE of Port Heiden

Depth: 44 km  
Magnitude: ML 3.7



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
