### ALASKA EARTHQUAKE INFORMATION CENTER

The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Monday, June 30th at 9:34 AM AKDT in southeastern Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.4 and was located at a depth of about 6 miles (10 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. No reports of this event being felt or causing damage have been received at this time.

111 km ( 69 miles) WNW of Gustavus  
113 km ( 71 miles) NW of Pelican  
123 km ( 77 miles) SW of Klukwan

140 km ( 88 miles) WNW of Hoonah  
154 km ( 96 miles) WSW of Skagway  
155 km ( 97 miles) SE of Yakutat

The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
