The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Sunday at 01:48 am ADT in the Alaska Peninsula region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.4 and was located at a depth of about 0 miles (0 km).

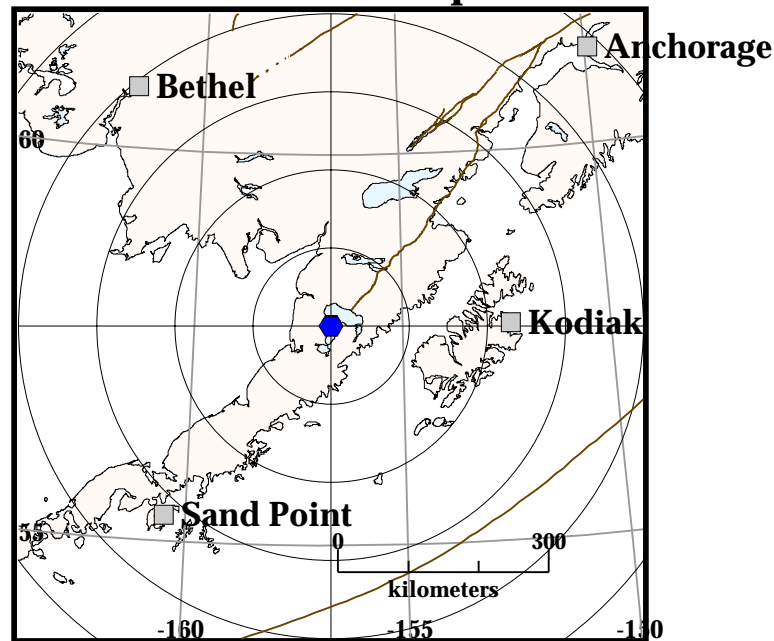
No reports of this event having been felt and/or causing damage have been received at this time.

- 36 mi (58 km) ENE of Pilot Point
 - 37 mi (59 km) SE of Egegik
 - 61 mi (98 km) S of King Salmon
 - 63 mi (102 km) S of South Naknek
 - 64 mi (104 km) S of Naknek
 - 86 mi (138 km) WNW of Karluk
 - 90 mi (145 km) S of Levelock
 - 96 mi (154 km) NE of Port Heiden
