### ALASKA EARTHQUAKE INFORMATION CENTER

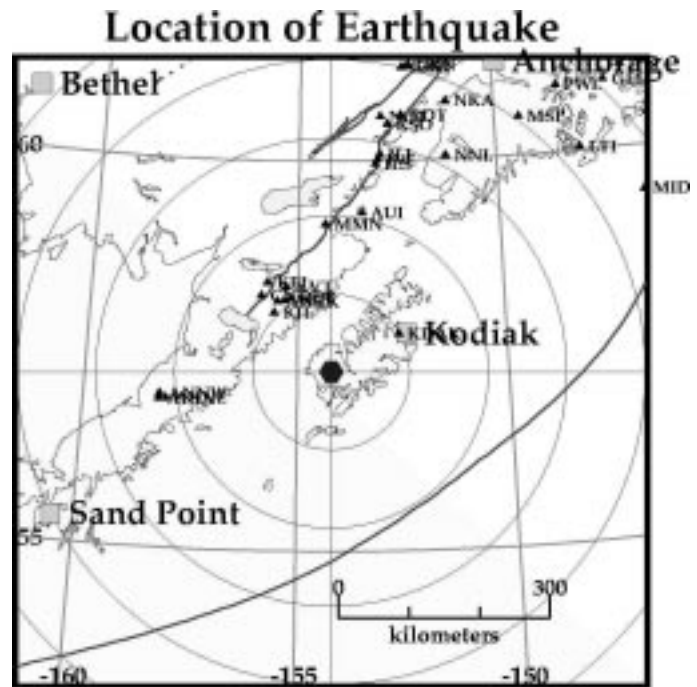
The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Monday, May 8th at 12:41 PM AKDT in the Kodiak Island region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.5 and was located at a depth of about 6 miles (10 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. This event was felt strongly in Larsen Bay and Old Harbor.

#### Distance to nearby locations:

- 29 km ( 18 miles) SSW of Larsen Bay
- 34 km ( 21 miles) SSE of Karluk
- 40 km ( 25 miles) N of Akhiok
- 55 km ( 34 miles) WNW of Old Harbor
- 101 km ( 63 miles) SW of Port Lions
- 120 km ( 75 miles) WSW of Kodiak
- 122 km ( 76 miles) WSW of Ouzinkie
- 204 km ( 128 miles) E of Pilot Point

#### Preliminary earthquake parameters:

Latitude:	57 N 18'
Longitude:	154 W 12'
Depth:	10 km
Magnitude:	ML 4.5



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
