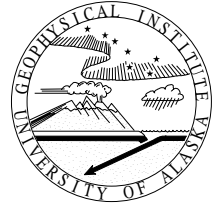

The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Friday, October 13th at 8:12 AM AKDT in the Unimak Island region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.4 and was located at a depth of about 38 miles (61 km).

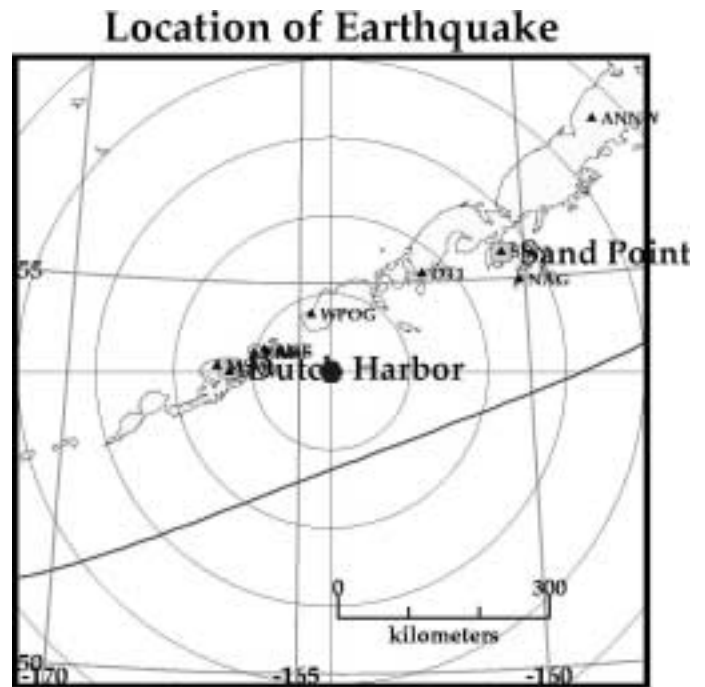
No reports of this event being felt or causing damage have been received at this time.

Distance to nearby locations:

- 100 km (62 miles) ESE of Akutan
- 124 km (78 miles) SSW of False Pass
- 145 km (90 miles) E of Dutch Harbor
- 146 km (91 miles) E of Unalaska
- 179 km (112 miles) SW of Cold Bay
- 185 km (116 miles) SW of King Cove
- 295 km (185 miles) WSW of Sand Point
- 310 km (194 miles) SW of Nelson Lagoon

 Latitude: 53 N 52'
 Longitude: 164 W 19'
 Depth: 61 km
 Magnitude: ML 4.4



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
