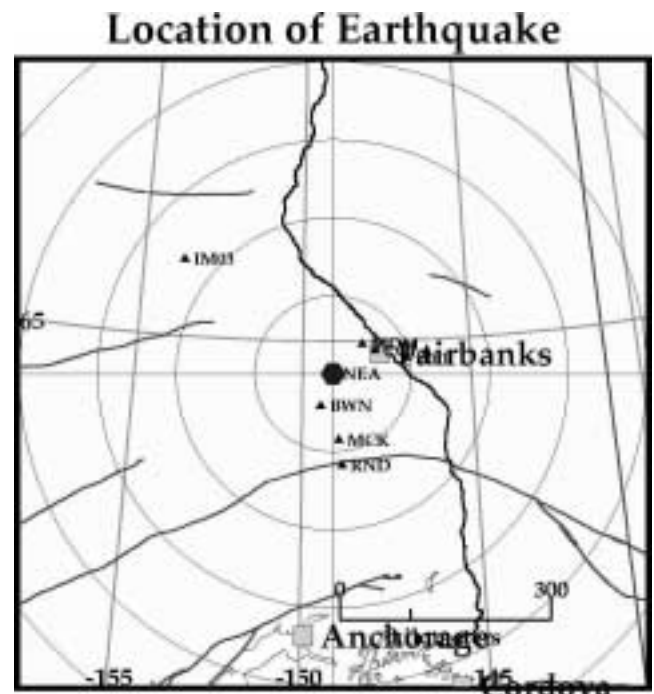
The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located an earthquake that occurred on Thursday, March 29th at 10:22 AM AKST in the central region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 1.8 and was located at a depth of about 13 miles (21 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. This event was felt in Fairbanks, and no reports of damage have been received at this time.

#### Distance to nearby locations:

3 km ( 2 miles) NNW of Nenana  
27 km ( 17 miles) N of Clear  
60 km ( 37 miles) WSW of Ester  
64 km ( 40 miles) S of Minto  
72 km ( 45 miles) WSW of Fairbanks  
76 km ( 48 miles) WSW of Fort Wainwright  
81 km ( 51 miles) N of Healy  
82 km ( 51 miles) WSW of Fox

Latitude: 64 N 35'  
Longitude: 149 W 06'  
Depth: 21 km  
Magnitude: ML 1.8



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
