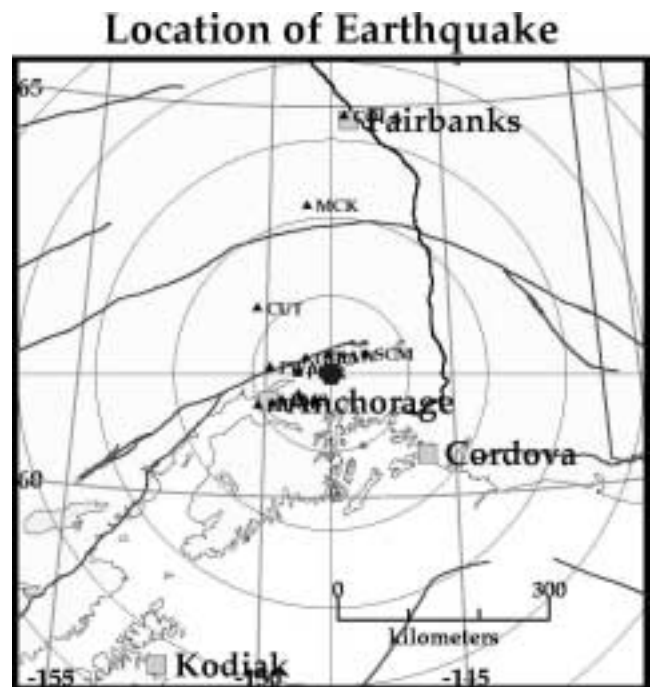
The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a minor earthquake that occurred on Friday, April 27th at 2:41 PM AKDT in the Prince William Sound region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 3.9 and was located at a depth of about 24 miles (38 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. This event was felt in Palmer, however no reports of damage have been received at this time.

Distance to nearby locations:

- 37 km (23 miles) ESE of Sutton
- 46 km (29 miles) E of Palmer
- 60 km (37 miles) ESE of Hatcher Pass
- 63 km (39 miles) E of Wasilla
- 69 km (43 miles) ENE of Chugiak
- 76 km (48 miles) ENE of Eagle River
- 85 km (53 miles) ENE of Fort Richardson
- 87 km (54 miles) NE of Girdwood

Preliminary earthquake parameters:

Latitude: 61 N 35'
Longitude: 148 W 15'
Depth: 38 km
Magnitude: ML 3.9



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.

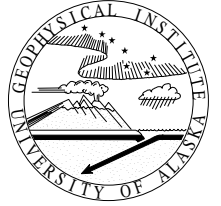
