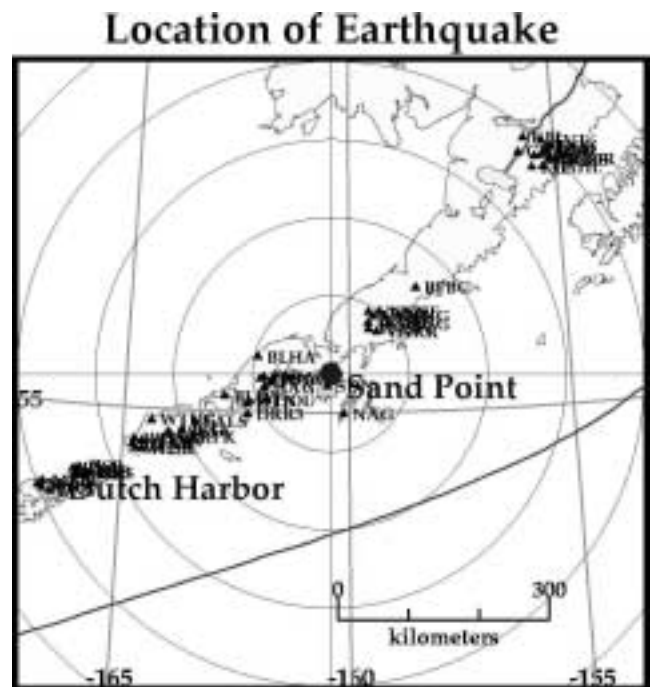
The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a minor earthquake that occurred on Tuesday, October 7th at 1:51 PM AKDT in the Alaska Peninsula region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 3.5 and was located at a depth of about 41 miles (65 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. This event was felt in Sand Point. No reports of this event causing damage have been received at this time.

Distance to nearby locations:

19 km (12 miles) NNE of Sand Point
75 km (47 miles) SE of Nelson Lagoon
92 km (57 miles) WSW of Perryville
130 km (81 miles) ENE of King Cove
150 km (94 miles) ENE of Cold Bay
152 km (95 miles) SW of Chignik Lagoon
153 km (96 miles) SW of Chignik
191 km (119 miles) SW of Port Heiden

Preliminary earthquake parameters:

Latitude: 55 N 30'
Longitude: 160 W 25'
Depth: 65 km
Magnitude: ML 3.5



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
