The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Monday, November 10th at 4:08 AM AKST in the Fox Islands region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.6 and was located at a depth of about 14 miles (23 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. No reports of this event being felt or causing damage have been received at this time.

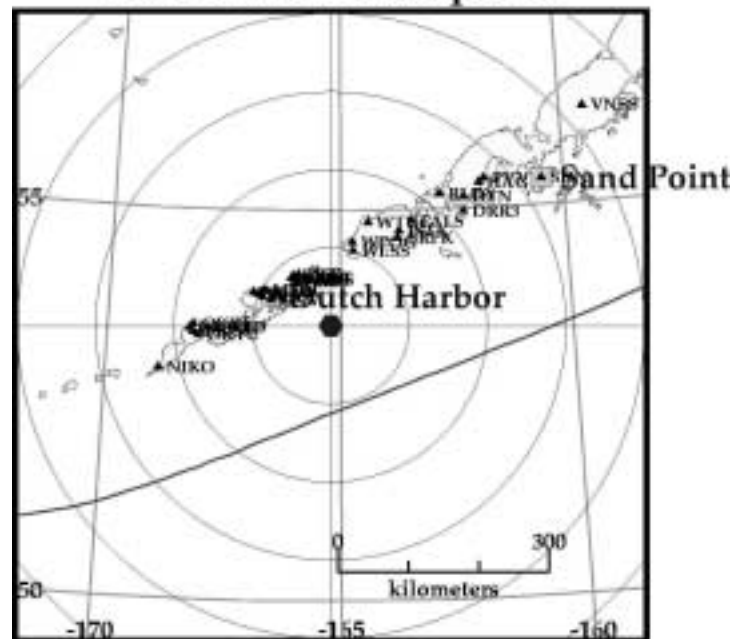
Distance to nearby locations:

77 km (48 miles) SSE of Akutan
95 km (59 miles) ESE of Dutch Harbor
95 km (59 miles) ESE of Unalaska
189 km (118 miles) SW of False Pass
245 km (153 miles) SW of Cold Bay
252 km (157 miles) ENE of Nikolski
254 km (159 miles) SW of King Cove
366 km (229 miles) WSW of Sand Point
