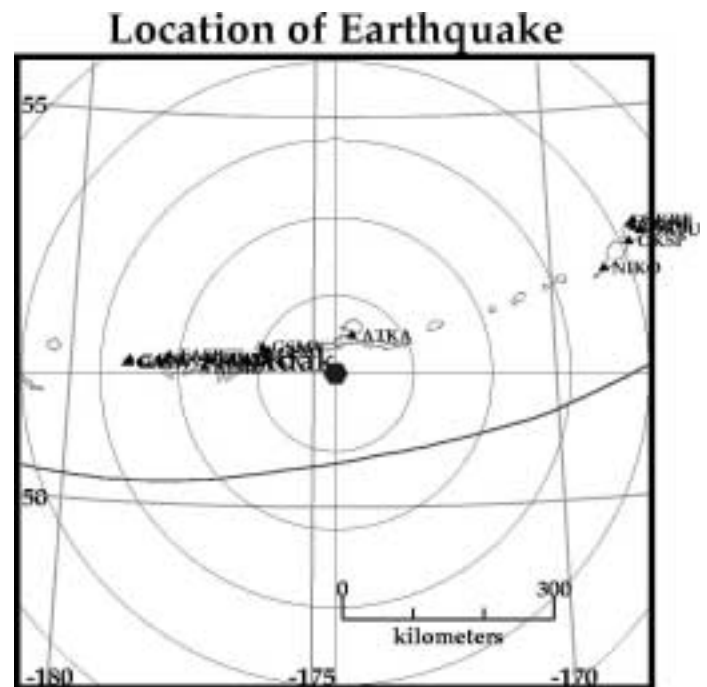
The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Wednesday, November 26th at 3:32 PM AKST in the Andreanof Islands region of Alaska. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.9 and was located at a depth of about 5 miles (8 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. No reports of this event being felt or causing damage have been received at this time.

Distance to nearby locations:

58 km (36 miles) SSW of Atka
146 km (91 miles) E of Adak
188 km (117 miles) WSW of Amukta Pass
409 km (256 miles) WSW of Nikolski
446 km (279 miles) E of Amchitka
589 km (368 miles) WSW of Unalaska
591 km (369 miles) WSW of Dutch Harbor
646 km (404 miles) WSW of Akutan

Longitude: 174 W 33'
Depth: 8 km
Magnitude: ML 4.9



Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.

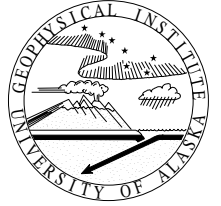
