## ALASKA EARTHQUAKE INFORMATION CENTER

The Alaska Earthquake Information Center located a light earthquake that occurred on Tuesday, November 14th at 8:58 AM AKST in the northern Yukon Territory. This earthquake had a preliminary magnitude of 4.0 and was located at a depth of about 4 miles (6 km). The magnitude and location may change slightly as additional data are received and processed. No reports of this event being felt or causing damage have been received at this time.

### Distance to nearby locations:

- 117 km ( 73 miles) NNE of Crooked Creek
- 126 km ( 79 miles) N of Eagle
- 153 km ( 95 miles) E of Circle
- 158 km ( 99 miles) ESE of Chalkyitsik
- 180 km ( 112 miles) SSW of Old Crow
- 191 km ( 119 miles) ENE of Central
- 204 km ( 128 miles) N of Boundary
- 212 km ( 132 miles) NNE of Chicken

Circles are 111 km (70 miles) apart.

The location and magnitude for this earthquake may be updated as data from additional seismic stations are received. The Alaska Earthquake Information Center will continue to gather data and may issue additional releases as appropriate. With any moderate or large earthquake, aftershocks should be expected to occur.
